

University of Toronto Student Commons

In 2015 superkül was delighted to be selected to design the new student centre for the University of Toronto's St. George campus. Named the Student Commons, this new facility currently under construction will integrate many of the student spaces and services currently dispersed across the campus.

The project includes the renovation and expansion of an early-20th-century building on a prominent corner of the University's urban campus. Originally built for the Royal College of Dental Surgeons in 1909, the building was most recently occupied by the Faculty of Architecture, Landscape & Design. Its redesign as the new Student Commons respects the historic brick-and-limestone exterior while transforming the building into a welcoming, accessible and outward-looking facility that meets current and contemporary student needs. When complete, the Commons will deliver programming, community space and essential services for students – wholly under student governance, management and operation.
